The Daily Flex Pass allows you to have a credit card on file that automatically charges you the daily parking rate when your vehicle enters state beach parking lots and allows you to use the express lane at larger state beaches. Narragansett Beach

Beautiful local beach just 2.5 miles from the cottage. Daily Admission. The Town Beach opens Memorial Day weekend. The Town Beach will be closed from Tuesday after Memorial Day weekend thru the first Friday after Memorial Day Weekend (no staff or Lifeguards will be on duty as the staff is still in school). The beach will open full-time and charge 7 days a week for the season on the first Saturday after Memorial Day Weekend thru the Monday after Labor Day Weekend.

Daily admission is \$12 per person per day and is not transferable. Daily Admission is available to residents/taxpayers and non-residents (payment by Cash or Credit Card) Children 11 and under are free. ATM machines are available at both the South and North Pavilions of the Beach. There is paid parking in a lot across from the beach for non-Narragansett Residents. After passing the Newport/Jamestown Bridge Exit continue driving on Route 1 North for 7.5 miles to Exit 7 (Quonset). Take Route 403 for 3 miles and then stay Left following the signs to Quonset. Continue on Route 403/Quonset Rd. for 3.5 miles to the water, we are on the right-hand side. Look for the Martha's Vineyard Ferry signs.

Casey Farm

Established in the eighteenth century as a plantation, today it's a working farm with organically grown produce for a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program. Tour the farmyard to visit the animals, the cemetery where six generations of Caseys are buried, and the farmhouse museum gallery featuring family portraits and cultural objects representing all the people of this land.
